

LEGAL NOTICE

The Manchester Transit Authority (MTA) will hold a public hearing on **Tuesday, April 22, 2014** from 2:00 to 4:00 PM and 6:00 to 8:00 PM in the Aldermanic Chambers, City Hall Plaza, 1 City Hall Plaza, Manchester, NH to discuss proposed service changes and fare increase.

PROPOSED SERVICE CHANGES

In an effort to improve the efficiency of Manchester's city bus system, the MTA is proposing the following service changes:

- Reroute route 6 (Bremer St) to end at Hannaford rather than former Shaws. Additionally reroute to follow same path inbound as outbound, eliminating service on Rockland/Sylvester portion of route. Variations under consideration with and without service to St. Anselm's College.
- Restructure StepSaver service area to accommodate origins and destinations that are within $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile of a fixed route only.
- Changes in times and/or number of trips for Routes 4 (Concord) and 9 (Nashua).
