### Notice of Public Hearing

A public hearing will be held at the Manchester Transit Authority, 110 Elm Street, Manchester, NH 03102-2799, on Tuesday, July 28, 2015 at 5:00 PM to consider a Program of Projects (POP) for Federal operating and capital assistance under Section 5307 of the Federal Transit Act.
