The MTA is pleased to announce a new partnership with the Town of Goffstown to provide curb to curb transportation to residents of Goffstown. The service will be available every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday between the hours of 9:00 AM and 2:00 PM. Preference is given to seniors and residents traveling for medical purposes but service is available to all residents. Transportation is available to and from any address in Goffstown as well as medical locations in Manchester or Bedford. There is no fare for the service but advanced reservations are required and may be scheduled by calling MTA at 603-623-8801 at least 1 day in advance.

Funding for this pilot program is provided by the Town of Goffstown and by FTA Section 5310 Purchase of Service funds allocated by the Regional Coordinating Committee (RCC) lead by the Southern New Hampshire Planning Commission. The Pilot Program is expected to last for two years during which time service will be amended to best meet the transportation needs of the community in a financially sustainable manner. The first day of service will be Wednesday, July 1st, 2015.
