Re: **MTA Rider Fare Restoration**

Beginning November 1, 2020 MTA will be charging passenger fares again. Passes that are currently inactivated, but still valid, may be used as normal. Passengers using MTA Fixed Route, StepSaver and CART will be charged the standard fare for each trip as outlined in the fare structure (see below).

Passengers will be able to purchase tickets online, at the Welcome Center or on the bus. Day, Week and Month passes are available on the bus for purchase. However, cash denominations greater than a \$50 bill are not accepted in the fare box and excess cash is not kept at the Welcome Center.

Passengers will be required to show half-fare verification as described in the Passenger Guidelines located on the website and in the schedule pamphlet. This includes the U-Pass program. Please note, MCC students will not be providing a student ID card as they have not been issued them for this school year, all other University students will still use their student ID. All University passengers will need a U-Pass fare card to ride. As always, the Operator will tally the passengers appropriately in the fare box.
